

**TOWN OF MONUMENT
RESOLUTION NO. 21-2013**

**A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE CITY OF COLORADO SPRINGS'
APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE COLORADO
REGIONAL TOURISM ACT (APPROVED)**

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2013, the City of Colorado Springs submitted an application for funding under the Colorado Regional Tourism Act for the “City for Champions” project; and

WHEREAS, the City for Champions Project includes four components: a United States Olympic Museum; a Downtown Stadium and Event Center; the United States Air Force Academy Gateway at Falcon Stadium Visitors Center; and the UCCS Sports Medicine and Performance Center; and

WHEREAS, the City for Champions Project is of an “extraordinary and unique nature and is reasonably expected to contribute significantly to economic development and tourism” in the state and importantly in the Colorado Springs community; and

WHEREAS, the potential for a positive impact to the region and attraction of visitors to the Town of Monument would be desirable.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MONUMENT, COLORADO THAT:**

1. the Town of Monument Board of Trustees endorses the application submitted by the City of Colorado Springs for funding under the Colorado Regional Tourism Act; and
2. the Board of Trustees respectfully requests that the Colorado Economic Development Commission approve the application for funding submitted by the City of Colorado Springs; and
